


Missouri's Wetland Conservation Areas



1. Nodaway Valley Conservation Area is north of St. Joseph. From I-29, exit onto Highway 59. Head west for 3.5 miles, then north 9 miles on Highway B.

2. Bob Brown Conservation Area is 2.5 miles west of Forest City on Old Highway 111.

3. Fountain Grove Conservation Area is 5 miles south of Meadville on Highway W.

4. Grand Pass Conservation Area is 8 miles west of Marshall on Highway 65, then 5 miles north on Highway N.

5. Eagle Bluffs Conservation Area is in Boone County. From Columbia, go south on Providence Road (Route K) past McBaine, then turn left on Star School Road.

6. Ted Shanks Conservation Area is 17 miles south of Hannibal on Highway 79, then east on Route TT.

7. B.K. Leach Memorial Conservation Area is 3 miles south of Elsberry on Highway 79, then 3 miles east on Route M.

8. Marais Temps Clair Conservation Area is north of St. Charles on Highway 94, northeast on Highway H, then north on Island Road.

9. Columbia Bottom Conservation Area is in North St. Louis County. Take the Riverview Drive exit from I-270, then go north on Riverview about 2.5 miles.

10. Montrose Conservation Area is 12 miles west of Clinton on Highway 18, then 4 miles south on Route RA.

11. Four Rivers Conservation Area is 5 miles south of Rich Hill on Highway 71, 1 mile east on Route TT, then 2.5 miles south on gravel road 1600.

12. Schell-Osage Conservation Area is 6 miles west of El Dorado Springs on Highway 54, 12 miles north on Route AA, then 1 mile east on Route RA.

13. Duck Creek Conservation Area is 9 miles north of Puxico on Highway 51.

14. Otter Slough Conservation Area is west of Dexter on Highway 60, 10 miles south on Route ZZ, then 2 miles west on County Road 675.

15. Ten Mile Pond Conservation Area is east of East Prairie on Highway 80, then 5 miles south on Highway 102.
